SECTION 1

Information for Educators

Teachers, lecturers, and parents are encouraged to present the GLRC as an extracurricular activity for students interested in logic, reasoning, and analytical thinking. We provide specialized resources to help educators integrate the competition into their teaching and support their students.

The GLRC helps students develop analytical abilities by engaging them with a variety of reasoning problems. These tasks are suitable for use as assignments or academic projects. Additionally, instructors and institutions can apply GLRC materials in extracurricular clubs or workshops.

Importantly, the problems are designed to be accessible to students from a variety of backgrounds: from those with little to no prior experience in logic and reasoning to highly enthusiastic and knowledgeable learners. Through this approach, we aim to motivate a wide range of students to explore reasoning while offering exceptional students a chance to assess their skills and deepen their understanding beyond the traditional curriculum.

SECTION 2

Special School Awards

Schools and teachers with high participation and strong performance in the competition are eligible for special awards. While these awards do not include cash prizes, they recognize the dedication of schools and the commitment of individual educators:

School Award for Most Participants

1 Award

Awarded to the school with the highest number of registered participants in the Qualification Round.

School Award for Most Finalists

1 Award

Awarded to the school with the most participants qualifying for the Final Round.

School Awards for Excellence

Multiple Awards

Presented to schools demonstrating strong overall student performance, fostering a supportive environment for participants, or showing exceptional commitment to promoting logic and reasoning education through GLRC.

How do schools participate to win these awards?

Schools automatically participate when students register using the school's name. Please ensure all students enter the school name accurately and consistently. We also encourage teachers from participating schools to register for our educator platform.

SECTION 3

Teacher Registration Interface
